District Conventions:

MSP for meals as follows: \$5 for lunch, \$12 for dinner and free meals to anyone pre-registered under the age of 25.

MSP to invite all new candidate pastors to the District and provide registrations, meals and room.

Nominating Committee: Reported that Dallas Rosin as President and that Gary Bethke was considering the Vice President.

Resolutions Committee: Bob appointed Avonne Gessner and himself to serve on the committee.

International Convention: The 2010 International Convention will be held July 22-25 in Omaha, Nebraska. The bus will provide transportation from Fargo. MSP to commit up to \$2,000 for the International representative to attend the convention and to have him tour the ND District after the convention.

NEW BUSINESS

2010 Preliminary Budget: The preliminary budget was presented with changes requested to increase District Publications to \$250, the Winter Show to \$600 and Disaster Response to \$50.

Winter Show: (Report Attached) Bill asked for helpers during the 3 day show.

TV Set: Bob reported that the District has a combination TV and VCR that he has had for the past 4 years. It was decided to keep it and pass it on to the new President.
